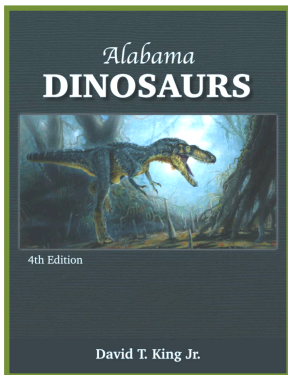
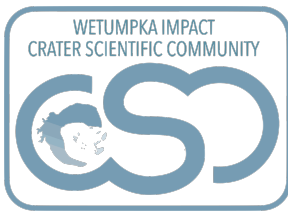

Dr. David T. King's degrees include: the University of Missouri-Columbia, Ph.D. in Geology, 1980, Carbonate petrology and stratigraphy, the University of Houston, M.S. in Geology, 1976, Sedimentology and stratigraphy and the University of Louisiana at Monroe, B.S. in Geology with honors, 1972.



Dr. King is a Professor of Geology, Dept. of Geology and Geography, Auburn University, Auburn, Alabama and has served there since 1980. Dr. King's primary research areas include: Geology of impact craters; impact-related stratigraphy and impact-boundary stratigraphy, Facies analysis and sequence stratigraphy of Phanerozoic sedimentary formations and Petroleum geology in southern Alabama basins and the basins of northern Belize, Central America. Since 1975, he has published over 70 peer-reviewed scientific papers on sedimentology, stratigraphy, impact geology, lunar and planetary geology, and dinosaur biogeography. Dr. King has also published an excellent book entitled, *Alabama Dinosaurs*.
